## ANNEX – L: DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR AND DISTURBANCES

Students, staff, and faculty are asked to assist in keeping Washtenaw Community College a safe place by being alert to suspicious behavior as well as reporting disruptive behavior and disturbances if they should occur.

## In those situations requiring the assistance of Campus Safety you should:

- Remain calm.
- Try to learn the nature of the disturbance.
- Identify who is involved in the disturbance.
- Contact the Campus Safety and Security office by calling 973-3411 or 3411 from a college phone, or by using one of the red emergency phones.
  - Provide as information as you can.
  - Be ready to describe the location of the incident, the number of participants, any weapons involved, physical characteristics and clothing worn by the participants.
- If you feel confident that you can calm the situation yourself, attempt it.

## Avoid taking physical action whenever possible.

- Position yourself away from potential harm
- Identify escape routes
